WHAT DID I DO?

Refresher LARC training in the first few months. Then set up the clinic in April '22 serving both GP sites in Bilborough. Unexpectedly gained a GP mentor and we started running joint clinics. We have fitted over double the number of LARCS compared to the same time period in '21. The care is much more holistic in primary care, aided by access to patient records - smears taken opportunistically, mental health discussions...

NOW: clinics are continuing post fellowship, yay! - 2 Friday mornings/month. At time of writing, 40

patients on waiting lists and growing.
